CORDET BAG No. 4819

Jack Frost Cordet—5 75-yd. Tubes
Interchangeable with Soutache, Ribbon Braid, or Straw
Size 5 White Crochet Hook

CIRCLES—Ch 5, join with a sl st to form a ring. Row 1—Work 6 s c in ring. Row 2—Work 2 s c in each st. Row 3—Work 1 s c in each st, 2 s c in next st; repeat from * 5 times. Continue increasing 6 sts on every row as described above until circle measures 6 in. in diameter. Work 1 row of s c around circle taking front loop to form a ridge on the inside of bag. Work 6 rows of s c, at st for, around circles, ending with a sl st.
Ch 3. Work 3 rows of popcorn st as follows: Row 1—Work 1 c in each of first 3 sts, 5 d c in next st, remove hook, insert it into the first of the 5 d c just made; draw the loop through (popcorn st); repeat from * to end of row. Join with a sl st.
Row 2—Ch 3, * work a popcorn st in the center of the 3 d c of previous row and 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts; repeat from * to end of row. Join with a sl st. Row 3—Repeat row 2.
Work 1 s c in each d c of previous row, skipping the popcorn sts, then work 5 rows of s c at st for. Work 3 rows of popcorn st pattern as described above and follow with 6 rows of s c, at st for (do not skip the popcorn sts on the first row). Finish with 1 row of popcorn sts around top of bag, working 1 s c between each popcorn st.
TABS—Ch 6. Work 5 s c on ch. Work back and forth in s c for 3 in. Make a corresponding piece.
HANDLES—Ch 7, * Work 1 popcorn st in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each of next 2 sts, 1 popcorn st in last st. Ch 1, turn. Work 1 s c in each of the next 4 sts, ch 3, turn; repeat from * for 14 in. Fasten to tabs with rings.

SOUTACHE BAG No. 4820

Jack Frost Soutache—2 Gr. Yds.
Interchangeable with Cordet, Ribbon Braid, or Straw
600 Wooden Beads
Size 4 White Crochet Hook

Row 1—Ch 111. Work 1 s c in 2nd ch from hook and on all remaining ch sts (110 sts). Ch 1, turn. Row 2—Work 1 s c in every st of previous row, taking back loop. Repeat row 2 until 12 rows in all have been made. Fasten off. Ch 40. Join to the 41st s c of piece just made with a s c. Work 1 s c over the next 29 s c. Ch 41, turn. Work 1 s c in 2nd ch from hook, 1 s c in each of next 39 ch sts, 1 s c in each of next 30 s c, 1 s c in each of remaining 40 ch sts (110 sts). Work back and forth on the 110 s c just made, taking back loop, for 11 rows. Fasten off.
INSERT—Ch 12, turn. Skip 1 st, work 1 s c in each of next 10 ch sts, 5 s c in next ch, 1 s c in each of the 10 s c on other side of ch. Ch 1, turn. Work 1 s c in each of 12 s c of previous row (the 10 s c just made, plus the 2 s c). Work 1 s c in each of the remaining 12 sts. Work back and forth in s c working 5 s c in the center st of the 5 s c of previous row as described above, until there are 40 sts on each side of the insert.
FINISHING—Sew inserts into the points on each side of bag, formed by larger pieces. Sew 1 row of beads on bag where inserts were joined, to cover seams.
BORDER—String beads on strong thread and crochet 1 bead into each s c around entire edge. Sew bag tog. about 7 in. on each side and across lower edge.

CORDET BAG No. 4821

Jack Frost Cordet—6 75-yd. Tubes
Interchangeable with Soutache, Ribbon Braid, or Straw
8 Bone Rings
Size 5 White Crochet Hook

Ch 5, join with a sl st to form a ring. Work 8 s c in ring. Row 1—Work 3 s c in first st, 1 s c in next st; repeat from * 3 times.
Row 2—Work 1 s c in first st, * 3 s c in next st, 1 s c in each of last 2 sts. Continue working round and round increasing 2 sts at each side of square by working 3 s c in center at corners, until square measures 7 in. in diameter. Work 1 row of s c around entire square, taking back loop only. Join with a sl st.
SHELL ST—Work 1 s c and 3 d c in first st, * skip 3 s c; 1 s c and 3 d c in next st, repeat from * around the square, working the next 4 sts; repeat from * 3 times ending with 1 s c in each of the 4 s c row. Work 1 row of s c around top of bag.
EDGING—Join cordet, * ch 5, skip 1 ch, 1 s c in each of next 4 ch, 1 s c in s c of previous row; repeat from * around top and lower edge of bag.
DRAWSTRING—Ch a piece 1 yd long. Work 1 s c in each ch. Make a corresponding piece. Sew the rings to inside of bag at top edge of lining. Draw strings through. Sew ends of drawstrings tog. to form a bow.

PLASTIC BAG No. 4822

Jack Frost Plastic used double—1 Tube
Interchangeable with Cordet, Gimp, or Straw
Size 2 Steel Crochet Hook

Row 1—Ch 76. Skip 1 ch, work 1 s c in each ch st on both sides of ch (150 sts). Row 2—Ch 3, work 4 d c in first st, * skip 4 s c, work 5 d c in next st; repeat from * for 1 round (30 shells). Join with a sl st. Row 3—Work 4 rounds and repeat Row 2, working the shell sts in the first st of shell of previous row. Repeat Row 3 until piece measures 7 in. in frst ch st row. Fasten off.
EDGING—Row 1—Ch 5, work 1 s c in frst d c of previous row, skip 4 d c; repeat from * around entire opening. Row 2—Work 12 s c over each loop of ch 5 on Row 1.
HANDLE TABS—Ch 7, turn, skip first ch, * work 1 s c in each of the next 6 ch sts. Ch 1, turn; repeat from * working into the s c instead of the ch sts, for 3 in. Make 4 pieces. Join to handles and sew to bag as illustrated.

SOUTACHE BAG No. 4823

Jack Frost Soutache—3 Gr. Yds.
Interchangeable with Cordet, Ribbon Braid, or Straw
Size 4 White Crochet Hook

Row 1—Ch 61, turn. Skip first ch, work 1 s c in each of next 10 sts, * 1 d c in next st, 1 s c in next st; repeat from * over the next 9 sts (11 sts), then work 1 s c in each of next 18 sts; repeat between *'s once. Work 1 s c in each of remaining 10 ch sts.
Row 2—Ch 1, turn. Work 1 s c in each st across the row (60 sts). Row 3—Repeat row 1, working the d c around the post of the d c on row 1 instead of into the st (cable st), and the s c into the s c of row 2, directly above the s c on the row below. Repeat rows 2 and 3 until 29 rows in all have been made. Make a corresponding piece.
GUSSET AND BOTTOM OF BAG—Ch 4, turn. Skip 1 ch, work 1 s c in each of next 3 ch sts. Work back and forth in s c, increasing 1 st at beginning of every row to 22 sts. Work even on the 22 sts for 9 in. or desired length, then decrease 1 st at beginning of every row until 3 sts remain. Join to lower edge and sides of bag with a row of s c.
HANDLE TABS—Work in cable pattern over the 7 center sts of cable pattern on bag for 3 in. on all 4 cable pattern stripes. Sew over handles.

PLASTIC BAG No. 4824

Jack Frost Plastic used double—1 Tube
Interchangeable with Gimp or Straw
Size 2 Steel Crochet Hook

SINGLE CROCHET STRIP—Ch 81. Row 1—Work 1 s c in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch (80 s c). Turn. Row 2—Ch 1, work 1 s c in each s c of previous row. Repeat row 2 until 10 rows in all have been made, or desired length. Make 3 strips.
MOTIFS—Ch 5, join with a sl st to form a ring. Row 1—Ch 3, work 4 d c in ring, * ch 2, work 5 d c in ring; repeat from * twice, ch 2, join with a sl st. Row 2—Ch 3, work 1 d c in each of the first 4 d c of previous row, * 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c over the ch 2 of previous row, 1 d c in each of next 5 d c; repeat from * twice ending with 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c over the last ch 2 of previous row. Join with a sl st. Work 1 row of s c at st for 25 around motif, working 3 s c in corners. Join with a sl st. Make 25 motifs.
CIRCLES—Ch 4, join with a sl st to form a ring. Row 1—Work 6 s c in ring. Row 2—Work 2 s c in each st. Row 3—Work 2 s c in every other st, with 1 s c in between. Continue increasing 6 sts on every row as described above, until circle measures 5 in. in diameter. Make 2 circles.
FINISHING—Join 7 motifs in a row, with a s c on right side to form a ridge. Make 4 strips; join alternately with s c strips, with s c on right side as illustrated. Work 1 row of s c around entire piece. Join sides tog. about 1½ in. from top with a row of s c. Fit circles into opening at sides and join with a row of s c. Work 1 row of s c around top of bag.

IMPORTANT

To insure a proper form, insert buckram between heavy satin linings and sew into bags.
